# **REPORTS:**

<u>Fire Dept:</u> V. Feldpausch stated FD will be interviewing candidate(s) this month to fill 3 open positions; they will be starting November 1<sup>st</sup>. He also discussed FD checking account.

<u>Clerk:</u> T. Koenigsknecht completed F-65; yearend report; FD & GF revenue and expenditure reports for month ending September 30<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Treasurer:</u> G. Arens stated he has collected \$870,532 for 92.8% of taxes due, 1223 of 1295 parcels for 94.4% so far and he will be attending a winter tax meeting scheduled for the end of October.

<u>Supervisor:</u> V. Feldpausch stated Hubbardston has our old tanker; we are using a loaner from ETankers and Dallas Township's tanker is not in Grand Ledge yet. He has conversed with Zoning Administrator and finished land division with Mike Bertram.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- 1. Wind Turbines: Filed an application for leave for the Supreme Court.
- 2. <u>Tanker:</u> ETankers still has tanker and projected completion date is November 2015.
- 3. <u>Clinton County Land Use Map Change</u>: Planning Commission met last week and are recommending to expand white area to the boundary line on Bauer Road. *Motion by V. Feldpausch*, supported by P. Schafer to accept the recommendation made by the Dallas Township Planning Commission for the Future Land Use Map with their revisions. *Motion carried*. V. Feldpausch will deliver map to Pete Preston.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Zoning Administrator's Report: Tammy Ziemlach-Foster stated she received two calls from residents asking where to find applications; spoke to B. Garrett regarding T-Mobile wireless tower modification on W. Walker Road and came to the Board regarding modifying fee structure if necessary. Attorney C. Patterson stated it supports the Temporary Zoning Ordinance (TZO). G. Arens made the motion; supported by S. Schafer to amend Resolution 2015-2 to add New Tower Cost \$500 and Modification that meets statute \$200 charge. Roll call vote was taken: Ayes: Arens; Feldpausch; S. Schafer; Koenigsknecht; P. Schafer. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- 2. <u>Burnham & Flower Insurance:</u> L. Cleaver explained to the township board the process for additional coverage on zoning coverage for township officials. The current zoning limit is \$100,000 and Mr. Cleaver stated that it's very difficult for entities to obtain higher coverage for zoning from most insurance companies.
- 3. Year End Report: T. Koenigsknecht disseminated the FD & GF yearend report and asked for any questions. A motion was made by S. Schafer, supported by V. Feldpausch to accept the 2014-2015 yearend report. Motion carried.
- 4. <u>County Commissioners Report:</u> Commissioner Pohl stated Clinton Lakes is setting up a goose hunt; Court House is paid off; public hearing October 13<sup>th</sup> on the budget; County reviewed the Post Retirement Health Care Plan using 7% estimated return and voted to change it to 6.5%; reviewed MMDHD contract; and \$63,000 funded per year for mental health for inmates.
- 5. MTA Conference Approval January 19 22, 2016 Detroit: A motion was made by T. Koenigsknecht supported by V. Feldpausch to allow Dallas Twp board members to attend the MTA Conference in Detroit. Motion carried.
