# DALLAS TOWNSHIP Minutes of the Regular Monthly Board Meeting June 6, 2017 @ 7:00 p.m.

<u>Call to Order:</u> The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Feldpausch at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

<u>Minutes of Meeting – May  $2^{nd}$ :</u> A motion was made S. Schafer, supported by V. Feldpausch to approve the minutes from the May  $2^{nd}$  monthly board meeting. Motion carried.

<u>Additions or Correction to Agenda/Approval of Agenda:</u> **A motion was made by S. Schafer,** supported by A. Schafer to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

<u>Approval of Bills:</u> A motion was made by T. Koenigsknecht, supported by A. Schafer to approve the payment of the following bills: General Fund \$10,214.79 and Fire Fund \$12,773.83. Motion carried.

# **REPORTS:**

<u>Fire Dept:</u> V. Feldpausch stated the new pay system is running smoothly and department is working on a grant for radios.

<u>Clerk:</u> T. Koenigsknecht attended election equipment meeting on May 4<sup>th</sup>; met with Burnham & Flower Rep Larry Cleaver on May 17<sup>th</sup>; received two calls regarding high pitch noise @ cell tower on Walker Rd.; assisted with updates to township web page; worked with Zoning Administrator and attorney regarding zoning map, legal ads, etc. in preparation for the Planning Commission Public Hearing on June 19<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Treasurer:</u> A. Schafer disseminated newsletters and newly designed tax bills and asked for input; and will be collecting taxes at the Village of Fowler office starting this year.

<u>Supervisor:</u> V. Feldpausch has completed one land division and working on two others and had discussions with residents regarding gravel roads in township.

### UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. <u>Wind Turbines:</u> No news.

2. <u>Medical Marihuana:</u> This will be added within the Permanent Zoning Ordinance so it can be deleted under Old Business.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. <u>County Commissioners Report</u>: Commissioner Pohl stated the County approved compensation/classification study; County is loaning \$250,000 to the drain fund; County adopted a Solar Ordinance; audit went well with pension fund at 92.1% and healthcare is at 113% funded; and continued problems at Eagle mobile home park.

2. <u>Zoning Administrator's Report:</u> Zoning Administrator T. Foster stated Cypress Renewables contacted her regarding solar farms along M-21 and Jones Road; worked with County GIS department to develop a draft zoning map; and spoke about potential splits in southwestern part of the township and also flag locks.

3. <u>MTA Principals of Governance</u>: T. Koenigsknecht presented this from the MTA. **A motion was made by V.** Feldpausch, supported by A. Schafer to support the MTA Principals of Governance. Motion carried.

4. <u>MTA Participating Plan Board of Directors Election Ballot:</u> A motion was made by V. Feldpausch, supported by A. Schafer to nominate Gary Brandt as a board member of the MTA Participating Plan Board of Directors. Motion carried.

5. <u>Radio Quotes for D.N.R. Grant:</u> V. Feldpausch reported the same exacts bids for the same radios were obtained from Harris and Cynergey for \$4800 and it was decided to obtain radios from Cynergey. *A motion was made by S. Schafer, supported by T. Koenigsknecht to allow the fire department to order the radios from Cynergey. Motion carried.* 

6. <u>Survivair Bottle Replacement Quotes:</u> V. Feldpausch stated they are the same bottles and Douglas Safety received the bid. *A motion was made by S. Schafer, supported by A. Schafer to allow the fire department to order the bottles from Douglas Safety. Motion carried.* 

7. <u>Planning Commission Appointment</u>: V. Feldpausch stated that Jamey Myers was interested in becoming a member of the Dallas Township Planning Commission. A motion was made by V. Feldpausch, supported by S. Schafer to approve Jamey Myers as the new member of the Planning Commission. Motion carried.

8. Fowler Recycling Site Support - DWM Request: A. Schafer stated she received a letter from Kate Neese, Director of the Clinton County Dept. of Waste Management (DWM), in regards to continued support for the rural After brief discussion, a motion was made by Feldpausch, recycling sites. V. supported by A. Schafer to approve the \$15 per household fee to be collected during the 2017 Winter tax season. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Ken Farley spoke about concerns he has with the draft zoning map.
