Feldpausch spoke to residents regarding condition of gravel roads; spoke with CCRC regarding chloride prices raising; CCRC road project meeting is March 22nd 11:00 – noon; attended CCAA meeting; met on Monday with ISO rep who reported score of 9 in country and 5 in village. Larger tanker changed country score from 9 to 8B.

1. <u>Wind Turbines:</u> No news from attorney and Clerk received a call from Saginaw Township clerk regarding PPO.
