REPORTS:

<u>Fire Dept:</u> V. Feldpausch stated C. Koenigsknecht was attending a chief's meeting and the department has been relatively busy.

<u>Clerk:</u> T. Koenigsknecht stated she was emailed a draft copy of the audit and the township will not be charged for any additional journal entries (12) that were needed; working on the State F-65 and Statement of Monies Raised (L-4029 report) for the County Clerk; both due Sept. 30th and will pick up the dehumidifier within the next week for the township hall.

<u>Treasurer:</u> G. Arens stated he collected 562 of the 1291 parcels 41% and contacted County Treasurer Ward regarding the personal that he's been unable to collect.

<u>Supervisor:</u> V. Feldpausch stated he's met with Joe Thomas and tanker committee to iron out details of tanker; working with 9-1-1 on letter from Fowler Clinic to Central Dispatch for Priority 2 calls; and working with other potential buyer of township property.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. <u>Wind Turbines:</u> Have not heard anything from legal counsel on a decision from the Court of Appeals Oral Arguments from the hearing held on Wednesday, July 16th at 11:00 a.m.

2. <u>Hall Rental Policy</u>: There has been no interest from township residents on renting the township building.

3. <u>Tanker Bids</u>: V. Feldpausch stated if the Township accepts the bid from ETanker to modify the chassis, they can have the tanker finished by sometime in the Spring of 2015. The FD can lower the cost of the tanker by using various parts from the chassis. *P. Schafer made the motion, supported by G. Arens to accept the contract from ETanker for \$91,500. Motion carried.*

NEW BUSINESS:

1. <u>2015 Recycling Cost Share:</u> Kate Neese, DWM Director, is asking for verification in writing from the township regarding the 2015 Recycling Cost Share amount. *V. Feldpausch made a motion, supported by S. Schafer to supported the \$15 cost share amount. Motion carried.* T. Koenigsknecht will send a letter to the DWM information them of the motion.

2. <u>Township Property Purchase/Sale Agreement:</u> V. Feldpausch has been working with a potential buyer of the township's vacant lot west of town for an adult foster care facility. However, due to health problems with a family member, they are backing out of the purchase. Ken & Kathy Farley have shown interest in purchasing the property. G. Arens made the motion, supported by P. Schafer to accept the bid of \$52,000 from the Farleys to purchase the property. Roll call vote was taken: Arens – yes; S. Schafer – no; P. Schafer – yes; V. Feldpausch – yes; T. Koenigsknecht – yes. Motion carried.

3. <u>County Commissioners Report</u>: The new part of Motz Park is officially open; building of Rails to Trails has been progressing, however, Authority meetings have not been; public hearing October 14th @ 7 pm for Budget Hearing; there was discussion on upcoming Clean Community Recycling Event; retirement of Magistrate Jane Clark from District Court; Jail revenue from housing inmates has been running about \$125,000 and retirement of CCRC board member Russ Bauerle; he will be replaced by Gail Watkins.

There being no further business, a motion was made by P. Schafer, supported by G. Arens to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 pm. Motion carried.
